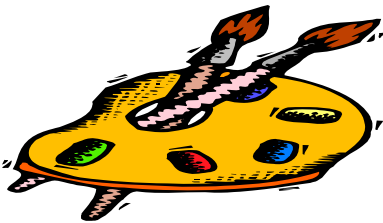
News for the Week
