- 1. HTTP (Hyper Text Transfer Protocol):** the protocol used to transfer data over the World Wide Web.
- 2. ISP (Internet Service Provider):** the company that you (or your parents) pay a monthly fee to in order to use the Internet.
- 3. Netiquette:** involves respecting others' privacy and not doing anything online that will annoy or frustrate other people.
- 4. Phishing:** an attempt to steal your personal information.
- 5. Search Engine:** index millions of sites on the Web, so that Web surfers like you and me can easily find Web sites with the information we want.
- 6. Social Networking:** allow users to be part of a virtual community and share their lives with other people without needing to develop and publish their own home pages.
- 7. Spoofing:** refers tricking or deceiving computer systems or other computer users.
- 8. Spam:** refers to junk e-mail or irrelevant postings to a newsgroup or bulletin board.
- 9. Upload:** sending a file from your computer to another system.
- 10. Webmaster:** the person in charge of maintaining a Web site.
